

# Admission Information and Instructions

Admission to Magnet Schools is by application only. The application deadline is **February 17, 2010**. Applications received, postmarked, or electronically submitted after **February 17, 2010** will be processed at a later date, pending space availability. Applicants who are not accepted **MUST** reapply each year.

**Siblings:** Applicants applying to elementary or secondary Magnet Schools who have a sibling (brother, sister, half-brother, half-sister, step-brother or step-sister, living in the same household) attending the Magnet School, and who will continue to attend that school the next year, will be placed in the Magnet School on a space available basis prior to placement of other applicants. Siblings must apply to a Magnet School in order to be considered. Secondary applicants must meet eligibility criteria.

Applications must be submitted by the **February 17, 2010** deadline for sibling priority placement.

**Notification:** Applicants will be notified by mail regarding acceptance or denial of their application.

**Registration:** Students must register at the Magnet School upon receipt of the acceptance letter to secure space and transportation. Registration deadline is indicated in the acceptance letter.
